GENERAL INFORMATION

Summer's Best Two Weeks, a non-denominational Christian sports camp, has been in operation since 1966. The purpose of Citikidz is to impact and develop Christian leadership in urban communities by providing educational experiences through Christian sports camps to the end that participants would begin authentic relationship with Jesus Christ and revolutionize their communities. We do this through introducing campers to a wide variety of activities: marksmanship, high adventure initiatives, canoeing, swimming, fishing, mixed martial arts, etc. Campers have the opportunity to advance their skills in individual sports. Each day, campers meet for Bible study and receive an opportunity to put life lessons into practice on the competition field.

LOCATION

Laurel Mountain Christian Camp is the summer home of SB2Dub Citikidz, located in the beautiful Ligonier Valley and surrounded by the Laurel Highlands just off the Donegal Exit (Exit 91) of the Turnpike.

COST

Citikidz is designed to provide an affordable encounter with Christ for campers from **8-18** years old. While the tuition for each camper is **\$120**, each participant in our camps actually costs \$900.00. So each participant receives a substantial scholarship and God provides the rest by His grace, as we raise the remaining balance of tuition costs through the support of donors throughout the country. COUNSELOR/STAFF

We carefully select and recruit staff from a pool of applicants at major universities and smaller private and/or Christian colleges. Two intensively trained SB2Dub collegiate staff will live with every ten youth in a cabin. Counselors build personal relationships with their campers through a variety of shared experiences; coaching competitions, spending "one-on-one" time, mealtimes, cabin devotionals, and group sessions following evening programs.

USE OF PHONE

We are fully aware of our great responsibility to care for each child. In case of emergency, physical or otherwise, parents will be notified immediately. Consequently, we do not allow incoming or outgoing phone calls, including birthdays or other special occasions. (We will make exceptions to this only in absolute emergency.) Parents are welcomed and encouraged to write campers during his/her camp stay. All mail will be distributed at camp or returned after the camper has returned home. PLEASE be sure all parents are aware of this. Kaleos may get permission to use the phone by checking with the director.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There are four items required for SB2Dub Citikidz enrollment: **a. group registration form b. payment contract form c. policy review form d. appropriate deposit.** WE WILL NOT REGISTER A GROUP WITHOUT THESE FOUR ITEMS!

It is not necessary at the time you register your group to know exactly which campers you will bring. We suggest that you "guesstimate" how many boys and girls you anticipate bringing and register based on those numbers. 2021 will be a modified schedule, so groups have until **May 15 at 5 pm** to drop their numbers without penalty. If you drop your numbers or cancel your group after this date and time there will be financial penalty. (See Cancellations/Withdrawals)

If at any time you wish to add campers/Kaleos to your registration we require a written request accompanied by the appropriate deposit. You may add campers at any time up until your session begins as long as we have availability, however we cannot guarantee availability.

If you request spaces and camp is full, then your participant will be placed on our waiting list. After your registration has been received and processed, we will send an acceptance or waiting list letter and additional information that will help in scheduling your trip to SB2Dub.

The maximum number of campers per group is **40**, accompanied by 1 kaleo per 10 campers (unless other arrangements are specified with the director). **WE REQUEST MULTIPLE MINISTRIES register as SEPARATE groups!** All ministries must register separately, regardless of size! You are welcome to travel with other groups to SB2Dub, but **PLEASE REGISTER EACH GROUP INDIVIDUALLY TO AVOID CONFUSION ON ALL SIDES.**

*****NOTE*****

Returning groups from the immediately prior year who dropped more than 5 campers may only register for the number of campers that attended in that previous year, unless paying half of the full tuition balance up front.

CANCELLATIONS/WITHDRAWALS

ALL cancellations (whether for one camper or an entire group) MUST be written. A handwritten letter, fax, or an email notification is acceptable. No telephone cancellations will be accepted. This applies to waiting list spaces as well. We will not observe an item's postmark date. It must be in our office by the date required or it will be considered late and charges will apply.

Cancellations made by **May 15, at 5 pm**: the registration deposit for all camper spaces will be automatically transferred to another camper or refunded, but **NOT after May 15**. Deposits eligible for a refund may take up to 30 days to process.

Cancellations made between **May 16, and June 30, at 5 pm**: The deposit for all camper spaces cancelled during this time period WILL BE FORFEITED. The remainder of the tuition will be transferred to another camper or refunded. (If applicable)

Cancellations made after **June 30, at 5 pm**: There will be NO refunds for cancellations after this date and time! If you cancel campers after **June 30, at 5 pm**, the full camper tuition will be put into our scholarship fund with NO exceptions! The Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose influence and conduct becomes in any way detrimental to the best interest of the other participants of the camp. No refund will be made for absences, dismissals, or withdrawals before the end of the session except in cases of withdrawal during camp on camp doctor's orders, in which case remaining tuition may be refunded, if it is not due to a pre-existing illness or injury.
